



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

Extreme weather sorting mats





How to print and assemble

It works best to open up the file in Adobe Reader (a free program to install on your computer) and follow these instructions.



Enter the page numbers you wish to print (check the Table of Contents if you wish to print certain books).

Choose **PRINT ON BOTH SIDES OF PAPER.**

Choose **PRINT ON SHORT EDGE.**

After printing, make sure each book is lined up correctly. Then fold. Open back up and staple with a long armed stapler on the fold.

 wins!



