

How to Use These Scripts

Use these partner plays with young readers.

Level 1: Late kindergarten/early first grade

Level 2: Late first grade/second grade

Level 3: Second grade/early third grade

I recommend giving your readers a lot of exposure to the text before asking them to read it together independently. You might practice reading the text chorally during shared reading or guided reading. As students get better at the text, you can read one part while the class reads the other part.

When students are familiar with the play, put it at a partner reading center so they can read it independently in pairs. Encourage partners to read the play multiple times. They should work at reading the text smoothly and with expression. Finally, they should switch parts as time allows.
