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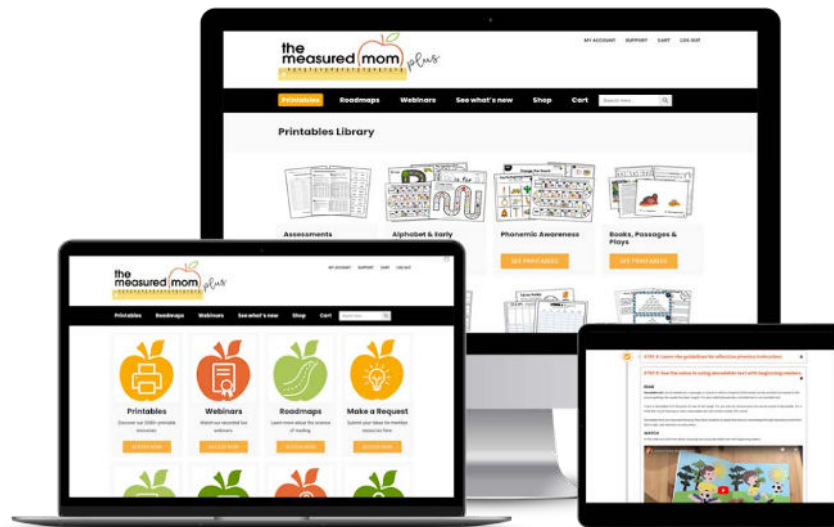
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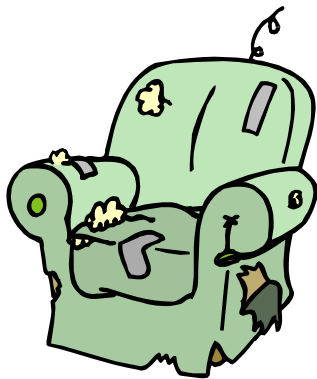
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O is for Old Chairs to Mend

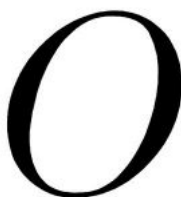


Old chairs to mend,

"Old chairs to mend!"

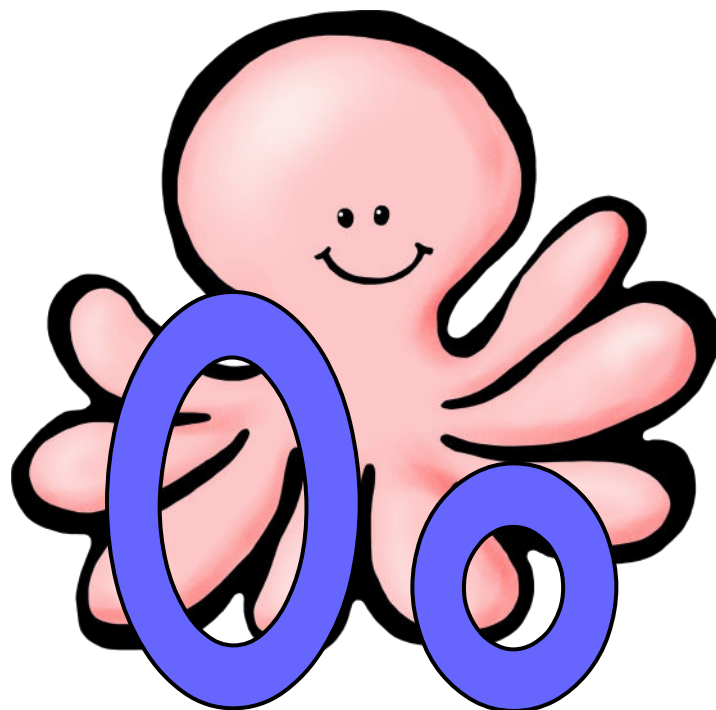
O is for Open, Shut Them
