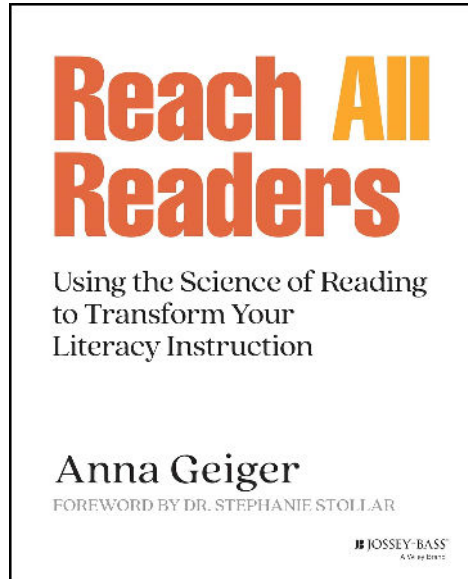

How to Use

- Use these arcs to help students learn letter names and sounds.
- Print the desired arc for each student and glue inside a file folder. Consider doing the following activities as a small group:
 - Point to each letter as you say its name.
 - Point to each letter as you say its sound.
 - Laminate the arcs and have students trace specific letters with dry erase markers.
 - Have students match letter tiles to the letters on the arc (these are provided with each arc; cut apart and store in plastic bags). Call out a letter and have students place it beneath the corresponding letter on the arc.
